



Perception of biological actions is normal after delayed bilateral congenital cataract surgery

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Development of biological action perception do not depend on typical visual experience during a sensitive phase in early infancy. By contrast, delayed treatment for bilateral congenital cataracts can have severe long lasting effects on perception of other types of movements, e.g. perception of coherent motion.
